ARTICLE I
Meetings

§ 9-1. Time, day and place.

The regular meetings of the Borough Council of the Borough of Canonsburg shall convene on every second Monday of each month at 7:30 p.m. in the Borough Building.

§ 9-2. Advertisement.

All regular and special meetings shall be advertised as required by law.

§ 9-3. Rules of order.

The Borough Council may, by resolution, establish such rules of parliamentary procedure for the conduct of its meetings as it deems appropriate. In the event that no such resolution is adopted, then Roberts Rules of Order shall be utilized in the conduct of meetings.

ARTICLE II
Compensation

§ 9-4. Amount. [Amended 12-16-1997 by Ord. No. 1216]

Each member of the Council shall receive compensation in an amount as set forth in Chapter 54, Salaries and Personnel Policies.

§ 9-5. Absence from meetings.

No compensation shall be paid for any month to a Council member who has failed to attend at least one regular meeting of the Council during the month.
