Must be 21 years of age to apply

In order to be eligible to test the candidate must:

- 1. Download the application or appear in person to pick up an application at the Canonsburg Police Department located at 68 East Pike Street (Bottom Floor) Canonsburg Pa. 15317 (Office hours are 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday-Friday. Closed daily from 12:00-1:00 for lunch)
- 2. Fill out and sign the application completely.
- 3. Attach the following required documentation
 - a. Proof of Act 120 Completion and/or Certification
 - b. High School (or Equivalent GED) or college diploma
 - c. If claiming veterans' preference eligibility attach your DD214
- d. Before returning the application, the candidate must read and understand the attached "Essential Job Functions" list
- e. Return the signed "Medical Release Form" to participate in the physical fitness portion of the test.
 - f. Proof of United States Citizenship and age. Attach Birth Certificate
 - g. Return the "Certification, Authorization and Agreement."
 - h. Resume is optional at this stage of the application process

*Application may be filed at any time. The applicant will be notified of the testing date and time. Each application received will be valid for one year.

The Police Officer Eligibility for Testing Application is the first step of the police candidate hiring process. Below is a general outline of the hiring process:

- 1. Application
- 2. Written Test (Testing four components: arithmetic, reading comprehension, grammar and report writing.)
- 3. Physical Agility Test (The physical agility test consists of 30 sit-ups within 1 minute, 1.5 mile run within 15.54 minutes, 25 push-ups within 1 minute, and a 300 meter run within 66 seconds. (The borough at its option may elect to include a 15.5 inch minimum vertical jump.)
- 4. Oral Interview (Scoring of the oral interview is combined with the written test to determine the candidates overall score for placement on the Civil Service eligibility list. (Valid for 1 year with option to extend the list to 2 years).
- 5. Background Investigation (If the candidate moves on to the background investigation they will be sent a comprehensive background application to assist the investigators)
- 6. Investigative (background) interview
- 7. Conditional offer of employment
- 8. Psychological Test/Medical Exam if required
- 9. 1 Year probationary period

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS (Including but not limited to the following list)

- 1. Affect an arrest, forcibly if necessary, using handcuffs and other restraints: subdue resisting suspects using maneuvers and weapons and resort to the use of hands and feet and other approved weapons in self-defense.
- 2. Prepare investigative and other reports, including sketches, using appropriate grammar, symbols, and mathematical computations.
- 3. Exercise independent judgment in determining when there is reasonable suspicion to detain, when probable cause exists to search and arrest when force may be used and to what degree.
- 4. Operate a law enforcement vehicle during both the day and night; in emergency situations involving speeds in excess of posted limits, in congested traffic and in unsafe road conditions caused by factors such as fog, smoke, rain, ice and snow.
- Communicate effectively and coherently over law enforcement radio channels while initiating and responding to radio communications.
- 6. Gather information in criminal investigations by interviewing and obtaining the statements of victims, witnesses, suspects, and confidential informants.
- 7. Pursue fleeing suspects and perform rescue operations which may involve quickly entering and exiting law enforcement vehicles; lifting, carrying, and dragging heavy objects; climbing over and pulling up oneself over obstacles; jumping down from elevated surfaces; climbing through openings; jumping over obstacles, ditches, and streams; crawling in confined areas; balancing on uneven or narrow surfaces and using body force to gain entrance through barriers.
- 8. Load, unload, aim and fire from a variety of body positions handguns, shotguns, and other agency firearms under conditions of stress that justify the use of deadly force and at levels of proficiency prescribed in certification standards.
- 9. Perform searches of people, vehicles, buildings, and large outdoor areas which may involve feeling and detecting objects, walking for extended periods of time, detaining people, and stopping suspicious vehicles and persons.
- 10. Conduct visual and audio surveillance for extended periods of time.
- 11. Engage in law enforcement patrol functions that include such things as working rotating shifts, walking on foot patrol, and physically checking doors and windows of buildings to ensure they are secure.
- 12. Effectively communicate with people, including juveniles, by giving information and directions, mediating disputes, and advising of rights and processes.
- 13. Demonstrate communication skill in court and other formal settings.
- 14. Detect and collect evidence and substances that provide the basis of criminal offenses and infractions, and that indicate the presence of dangerous conditions.
- 15. Endure verbal and mental abuse when confronted with hostile views and opinions of suspects and other people encountered in an antagonistic environment.
- 16. Perform rescue functions at accidents, emergencies, and disasters to include directing traffic for extended periods of time, administering emergency medical aid, lifting dragging and carrying people away from dangerous situations and securing and evacuating people from particular areas.
- 17. Process and transport prisoners and committed mental patients using handcuffs and other appropriate restraints.
- 18. Put on and operate a gas mask in situations where chemical munitions are being deployed.
- 19. Extinguish small fires by using extinguisher and other appropriate means.
- 20. Read and comprehend legal and non-legal documents, including the preparations and processing of such documents as citations, affidavits, and warrants.
- 21. Process arrested suspects to include taking photographs and obtaining a legible set of inked fingerprint impressions.

NOTE: The successful applicant must be able to perform ALL the above essential job functions of an experienced police officer, unassisted, and at a pace and level of performance consistent with the actual job performance requirements. This requires a high level of physical ability to include vision, hearing, speaking, flexibility, and strength.
